

Chordoma Foundation Doctor Directory

The <u>Doctor Directory</u> is made available by the Chordoma Foundation as an informational resource for patients and caregivers. The Directory includes the names of physicians who have given their permission to be identified publicly and who meet inclusion criteria developed by the Chordoma Foundation's <u>Medical Advisory Board</u> (MAB).

Inclusion criteria

In order to be listed in the Chordoma Foundation's Doctor Directory, a physician must attest that they meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Board-certified in neurosurgery, otolaryngology, radiation oncology, orthopedic surgery, or medical oncology.
- 2. Fellowship in a relevant subspecialty (e.g. skull base surgery) or at least five years of subspecialty practice experience.
- 3. Has personally treated ten or more chordoma patients in the past five years.
 - a. This does not include patients for whom consultation but no direct treatment was provided or patients treated by partners.
 - b. Multiple procedures performed on a single patient only count as one patient.
- 4. Has a commitment to improving the treatment of chordoma as demonstrated by at least one of the following in the past five years:
 - a. Published a peer-reviewed journal article on chordoma
 - b. Presented on chordoma at a national or international professional conference
 - c. Attended a Chordoma Foundation <u>International Chordoma Research</u>
 <u>Workshop</u> (ICRW)
